Programme of Events September - November 2008

Greetings Ramblers,

Sunday 7th September (Landranger Map 165) Leader: Paul Connolly

MEET: Marylebone 0930 for 0954 train to Little Kimble (arr 1057). **NB Please read "Fare" line below for advice on ticket to buy).**

LUNCH: Wendover – choice of shops, cafes and pubs in a 200 yard stretch, including one pub where you can eat your own food.

TEA: Aylesbury

DISTANCE: 12 miles, returning from Aylesbury. Mostly level, apart from a short climb in the morning. FARE: £10.55 cdr Aylesbury from Marylebone, £7.20 from Zone 6 boundary, both with Network card.

Freedom Pass holders only need cdr Amersham to Aylesbury (£5.30 with Network / Senior Railcard). 2 trains an hour back to London.

19th September to 3rd October 2008: Continuation of Compostella Pilgrimage: Maurice Hickman will be doing the third leg of the pilgrimage from Le Puy to Compostella between 19th September and 3rd October. On Friday 19th September he will get the 6 30 am Eurostar train from St Pancras to Paris Gare du Nord and thence to Gare Montparnasse, Toulouse, Rodez, and finally Viviez Decazeville. He will return on Friday 3rd October from Moissae, again by train via Montauban and Gare Austerlitz. DISTANCE: 10½ fairly strenuous miles, returning from Chesham.

FARE: Buy all zone travel card, including Zone D (only available at underground

stations). £4,80 with Network Southeast Card Discount.

When joining us on a walk please ensure you bring your Network cards or Gold cards so that you can get the 1/3rd off full fares for yourself and up to three guests traveling with you. You can also get £1.90 off all zone travel cards even if purchased at underground stations. Senior Railcard holders can also get the reduction on train fares but only for themselves.

Don't forget Sunday train services can be affected by engineering works eg trains from Charing Cross are sometimes diverted to begin from Cannon Street or Victoria. Information on these can be obtained by calling 08457 484950 or see National Rail Website at www.nationalrail.com
