Nomination slips are on the back page. If you want to nominate more than one person or do not wish to mutilate your programme feel free to make some copies.



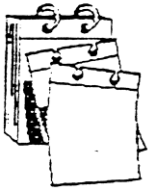
Peace Prayer of St Francis
