
Dear Ramblers,

It's been a sad beginning of Spring for farmers and ramblers alike with the outbreak of FMD. It makes us realise how fragile our environment can be...

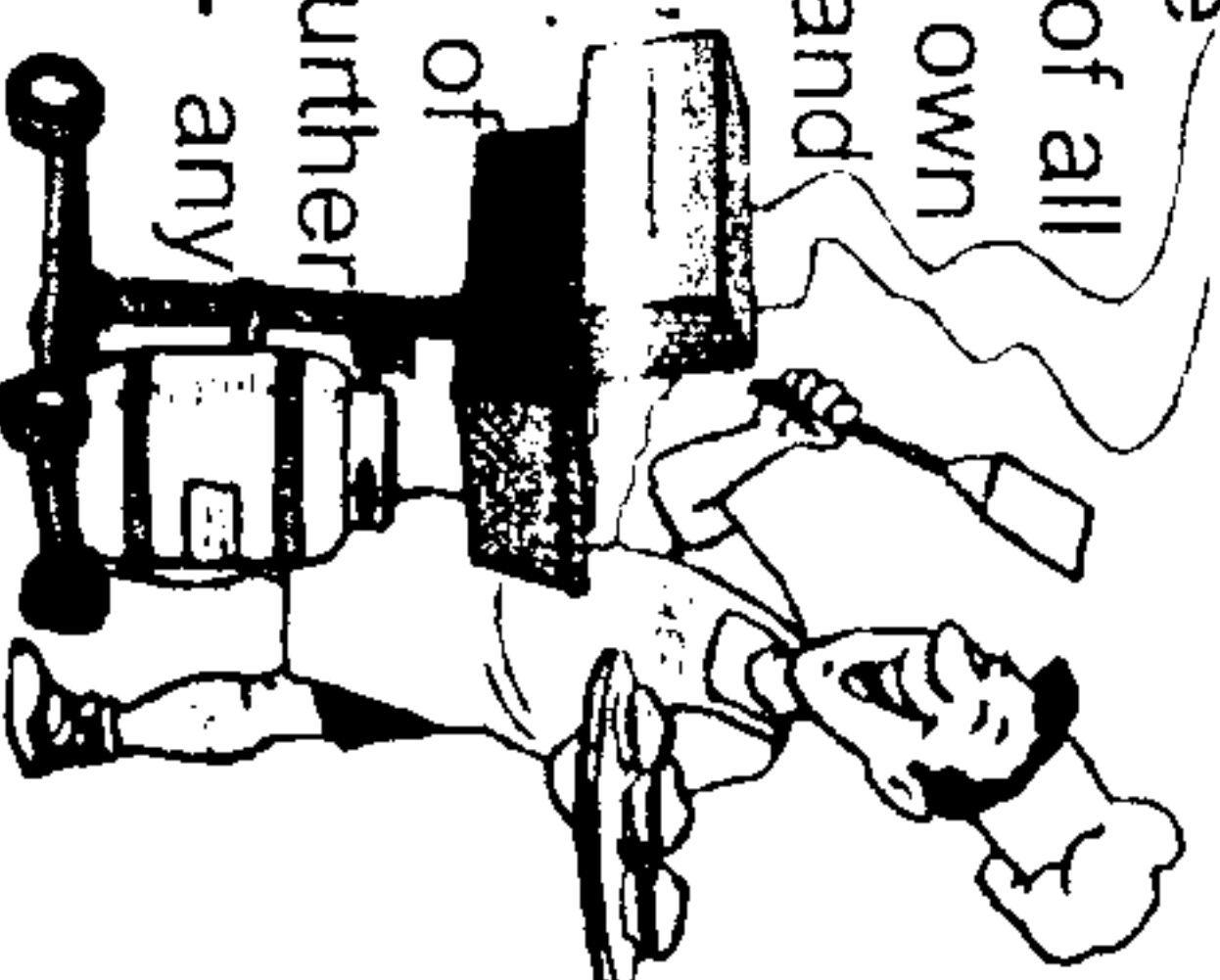
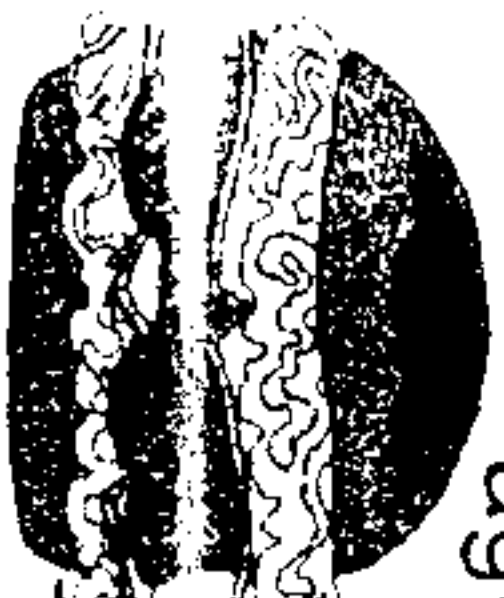

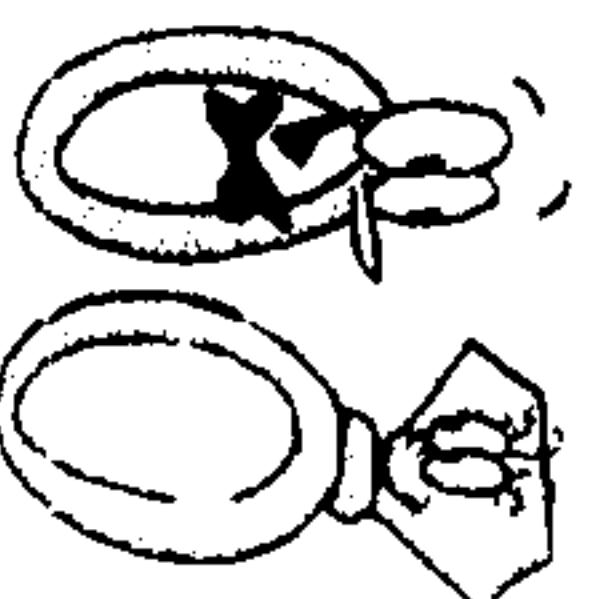
SPECIAL ANNOUNCEMENTS:

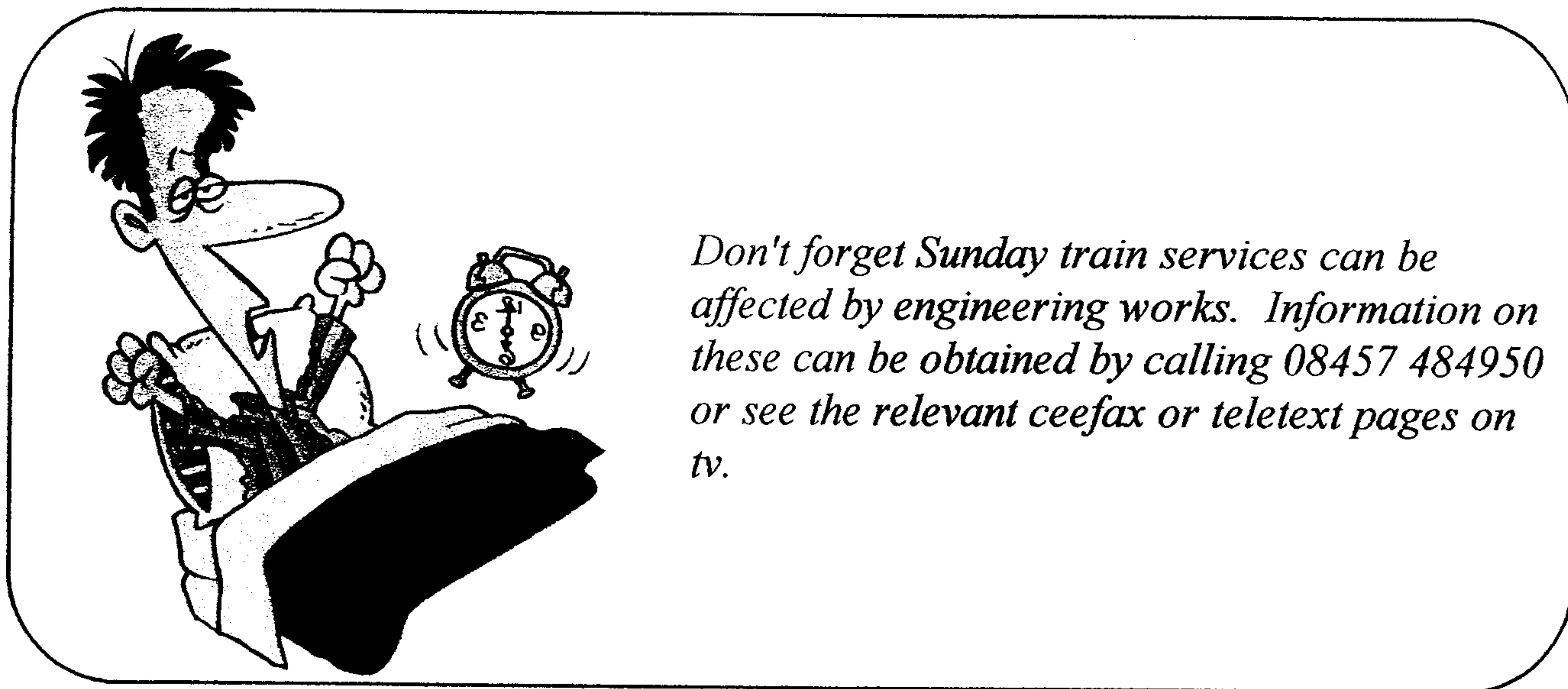
