The secretary of the day, Gill Fogden, can hardly have realised that, by listing Phil Evans among the club members, she was starting something which we would still be celebrating 43 year later.

No one will ever know how many days Phil has spent rambling, leading and walking out but it must all add up to what would be a tidy proportion of an average lifetime. We do know how many walks Phil has led thanks to the efforts of our late lamented Vice President, Fred McAndrews, who preserved copies of nearly every ramble list covering the period of Phil's first 25 years' membership, and it amounts to a massive 167 rambles. I have copies of the programmes for the time since then. As a special souvenir of his lifetime as a ramble leader this booklet contains details of all of them as they appeared on programmes over the years, as well as records of his many years dedication to the club committee.

Committee Membership: Phil's name appeared on a committee list within a year of the first ramble he led. He appeared as a member of the social committee on the first programme for the 1967-68 membership year. He told us he was prepared to step up to the main committee that year but there was such competition for places that he had to begin by being a member of the social committee (happy days which alas are now long past!!).

Just to prove that he was not a sleeping member of the social committee the following item appeared in the programme for March 1968:

FORTHCOMING EVENTS!!!

The 1973 Winter Programme saw the first of many appearances of Phil on the main club committee, this time as "Map Librarian".

The photographs that are interspersed in the remainder of this booklet will show the social and entertainment side of Phil in addition to his prowess as a ramble leader.
